Ghana, West Africa

Education

2005 - present

- Provide school supplies, teaching material and water quarterly for all the children living in 17 villages
- Provide teaching materials, textbooks and supplies annually for the students in 20 villages
- Conducted three-day training for 25 teachers in five villages
- Built a pre-school center in the village of Odoben (Central Region)—the pre-school students were using a goat shed as classroom space, with goats and goat droppings under their feet
- Built four primary schools in remote villages
- The Youth Missionaries renovated a dilapidated elementary school in the village of Nsaba (Central Region)
- Provide school supplies for school for the deaf/hearing impaired in Ghana
- Offer adult literacy program and writing classes in five villages
- Senior High Tech School in Wamanafo
- Built a library and supplied it with books
- Provided entire region with reading and math books
- Created computer lab with 20 computers and 10 printers

Economic Development/Agriculture

2008 - present

- We have a 100 acre farm in the Asikuma- Odoben – Brakwa District (Central Region) in Ghana that will serve as economic co-ops and a school feeding program.
- Acquired 100 acres of farmland in Wamanafo (Brong – Ahafo Region)

- Acquired 300 acres of farmland in Sunyanio (Brong – Ahafo Region)

Orphans/Vulnerable Children (OVC)

2005 - present

- Annual health examinations and prescriptions for 300 orphans
- Monthly our Ghana office (NGO) purchases food for the over 300 orphans in Bawjiase
- Provided books to completely stock the library at the on the grounds of the orphanage in Bawjiase.
- Provided three computers for the library on the grounds of the orphanage in Bawjiase and students in Wamanafo

Health

2005 – present

- Conducted free medical clinics with free prescriptions in villages in Ghana. We have seen more than 45,000 villagers.
- Provided medical equipment for three hospitals
- Provided two remote medical centers with everything they need to be effective in providing quality health care for community (medical equipment and free medicine).
- Purchased refrigerator for the medical clinic to store medicine (i.e., Typhoid is the leading illness in Ghana, and its medication needs refrigeration).
- Supply medicine and medical supplies quarterly (syringes, alcohol, pads, etc.).
- Supply medicine (infant/toddler/adults) and medical equipment for surgeries and general hospital care to General Hospital in Cape Coast.
- Supply medicine and vitamins for orphans in Ghana
- Paid for medical surgery for villagers in Nsaba, Odoben, Asabiem, Accra and Amanbete
